CARES 2 Grants: The deadline to submit a [budget modification](#) is **November 15, 2020**. Send budget modifications to OCFS at OCFS.sm.CARES2LR@ocfs.ny.gov.

The deadline to submit your [reimbursement forms](#) to the Council is **November 30, 2020**. Please submit your reimbursement form and all receipts to SuffolkCares2@outlook.com.

IMPORTANT UPDATE: For salaries, rent, mortgage and utilities being claimed in Month 1, you can include the 2 weeks prior to the month for a total of 6 weeks.

For example:

- If July is month 1, you can claim these expenses for the period June 15 – July 31st.
- If August is month 1, you can claim these expenses for the period July 15 – August 30th.

CARES 3: Grant application is [available online](#). The Council will **not** be administering the grants for CARES 3.
