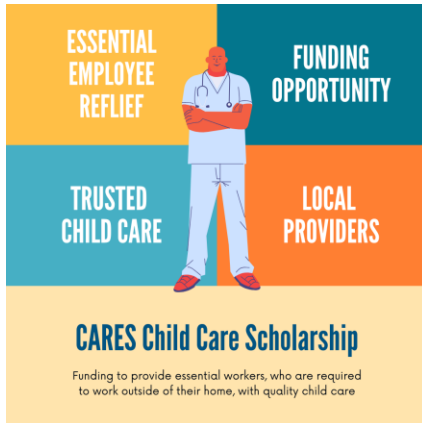

CARES UPDATES

We are still processing all of the **CARES 2 Grant** submissions for reimbursement. Payments are being made as we receive approval from OCFS. Thank you so much for your patience with this process.

The CARES 3 Essential Worker Scholarship was extended until February 21st for families who applied by January 10th. Any

parent who has an application pending - **the deadline to submit any outstanding paperwork (employment letter/paystub) is January 29th.** After that date, no additional documents will be accepted.

Invoices for payment must be sent to SuffolkCares3@gmail.com. Payments are being made at least 1x per week, but there is a lag of approximately 2 weeks from when you submit your invoice until you receive payment. We appreciate your patience with this process.
